One is that we can keep on hand more Bible Study/Theology books. As you know, we offer Samford University Extension courses here in the Fall and Spring semesters. It will be helpful to have more study resources on hand. Even in today's world, with all the internet access and available information, a person can learn a lot simply through the good, old fashioned study of a few good books.

The second reason is that these shelves will enable us to store (and loan) some of the new study modules/equipping centers. Many of our churches purchase these study units at the cost of several hundred dollars each.

Often, one group will use it as a study guide, then they will put it in the closet. My hope is that our churches will begin to place them here after the initial use. We can then catalogue them and post a list on our website, noting what is available.

This will be a good use of these costly materials. Our Lord expects us to be good stewards.

Utilizing the learning modules this way can save our churches thousands of dollars each year. Too, it can allow some of our smaller churches to take advantage of these helpful tools, when they otherwise likely would not ever think of using them because of the expense.

Let me urge you to lead your church to begin passing your learning packages along to the

Association. May I remind you, too, that we only need these boxes with CD or DVD's in them. Most of our churches can no longer even play the cassettes or VCR tapes. So keep the things that already are out dated. Share your blessings with the other churches.

I truly thank Bro. Robert for his fine work in building these cases. He did a great job! They look terrific. I appreciate this out of the ordinary way to use his talents for the Lord.
