All the glory for this accomplishment belongs to God. He gave the dream, the ability, the resources, and the working people to get this great job done. Praise to our great, good Lord for all His blessings!

As with so much of God's work upon this earth, He does use people. It would be near impossible to name all the people who have prayed, given, promoted, and just plain worked at this place.
