A visit with Dr. John

As Director of Missions for Coffee County Baptist Association, and in behalf of 48 sister churches, I offer congratulations to the congregation called The Church on Boll Weevil Circle. They are moving into buildings on their property at 2017 Boll Weevil Circle.

On June 5, 2016, 9:30 AM, they will have a special dedication service wherein they will offer thanks to God and dedicate the buildings, as well as their work and future, to God. Their emphasis is that God loves us, gave His Son so we could have forgiveness, and that we should love Him and people. They invite any who can, to be part of this worship service.

The establishment of this church gives a picture of the important connection between the churches, the Association, and our State Convention. The Association did not financially underwrite any of the work this congregation has done, but it has enabled the group in numerous ways over the years since its inception. The church's first year of meetings were in our association office. The State Convention gave about 1/6 of the cost of the property. Now they have partnered with this congregation by providing portable buildings.

Even the understanding of the need for a church on Boll Weevil Circle was because of studies conducted jointly by the Association, local churches, and the State Convention. It was almost a quarter century ago that our Association did studies, aided by experts from our State Convention, regarding the need for new churches or ministry points in our area. Local pastors/ leaders, and experts provided by the State Convention, agreed regarding the need for a church to be on this main traffic artery, at least for future generations.

That does not take away from the fact that these people, with God's help, saw the need, dedicated themselves to the task, and have overcome many obstacles to get to where they are.

There is a bright future! The faith, tenacity, and work they have exhibited thus far, will continue to help them achieve their goals. People who move to this area, as well as those who turn to the Lord here, surely will want to join these who have done so much with so little.

We rejoice with the church on Boll Weevil Circle upon this giant step and upon how the Lord has blessed them. We are thankful that they have been an active part of coffee Baptist Association from their beginning. Congratulations as you move into your new home!
