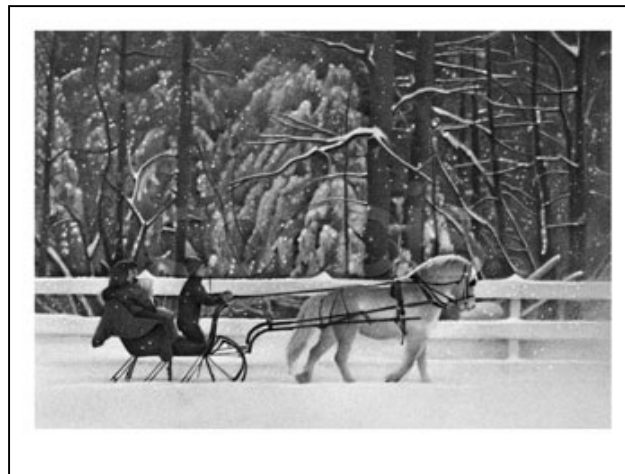
Finally, they are promoting the Coffee Cake baking for the Children's homes.

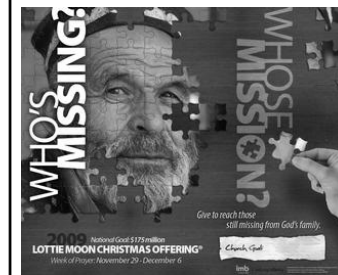
