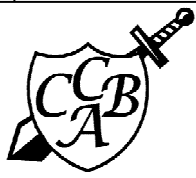

In 2007, we celebrated the 300th Anniversary of the first Baptist association in America.

Some people get troubled that we don't have a Baptist line of succession going back to the apostolic era. And it would be nice if we could point to a baton of faith called Baptist being handed down to each generation since the time of Christ.

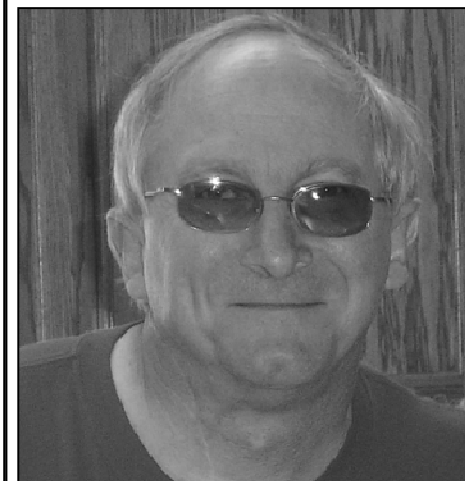
